Hepburn Wind Buzzing with Excitement

Hepburn Wind is buzzing with excitement. This is because the Board of Hepburn Wind is on the verge of releasing an important online survey that will help them gauge the community's interest in the project and renewable energy generally. Importantly, the results from this survey will be used to tailor the capital raising process to the community's needs.

The Chair of the Hepburn Community Wind Park Co-operative Ltd, Simon Holmes á Court, conveyed the feelings of the Board when he said: "As the beginning of the fundraising process this survey is very exciting. The fundraising process is well underway and we're very keen to understand how the community feels about the project so we can tailor it to the community's needs."

As well as providing an insight into the community's thoughts on the project the survey marks a milestone in the progress of the project.

Expressing this Board member Per Bernard said: "This project has been years in the making, and now after all the work of community members it's finally coming together. With this survey we will be designing the fundraising process, which is what will make this dream a reality."

Simon Holmes á Court continued to express the Boards' sense of anticipation when he said: "Everything says we're going to get a great result. We're looking forward to getting these results to confirm that this is truly going to be Australia's first community owned wind farm."

The survey has five questions and only takes a couple of minutes. It offers respondents an opportunity to indicate whether they would invest in a project such as the Hepburn Community Wind Park. However, the responses are not commitments, they are merely an aid in the planning of the next crucial stages.
